Kindly park in the Cancer Center garage. The entrance is located on Second St. opposite from the main entrance to the Cancer Center. (Second St. runs parallel to Prospect Ave. If you drive north on Prospect, go past the HUMC entrance to the next street, which is Atlantic St. and make a right turn --- If you drive south on Prospect turn left at Atlantic St. Go to the next intersection and turn left onto Second St. The Cancer Center garage is on the left). Tell the parking lot attendant that you are there for a meeting at the Cancer Center. **PARKING IS FREE.**

After you park, you may either:

1. Walk to the ground level and cross the street or
2. Take the elevators in the garage to the fourth floor of the parking lot. Look for the crosswalk entrance to the cancer center. When you enter the building, there will be an elevator on your left. Take elevators to the first floor lobby.

Follow the lobby around to the left (pass the Living Wall). Continue down hall and look for conference rooms on left after you pass the elevators.
