§ 100-1. License required.

No person shall conduct an auction without having first obtained a license from the Borough Clerk.

§ 100-2. License fee; duration of license.

The Borough Clerk shall issue the license upon payment of the required fee of seventy-five dollars (\$75.). The license shall be effective for a period not to exceed the thirty (30) days next succeeding the date of issuance.

§ 100-3. Violations and penalties.

Any violation of the provisions of this chapter shall be punishable as provided in Chapter 1, General Provisions, Article II.
