

Chapter 106**BILLIARD AND POOL ROOMS**

§ 106-1. License required.

No person shall own or operate within the borough a billiard or pool room or any other place where billiard tables are kept for hire without having first obtained a license from the Borough Council to do so.

§ 106-2. Application for license; hearing; grant or denial of license.

All applications for the licensing of billiard or pool rooms shall be made to the Borough Council. In addition to the information required by § 168-2, the applicant shall furnish recommendations as to his character and fitness from at least three (3) respectable freeholders of the borough. The Council shall fix a time for hearing such application and thereafter may grant or deny the same.

§ 106-3. License fee.¹

No application shall be heard or granted unless accompanied by a license fee of seventy-five dollars (\$75.), to be retained by the Council regardless of the disposition of the application.²

§ 106-4. Violations and penalties.³

Any violation of the provisions of this chapter shall be punishable as provided in Chapter 1, General Provisions, Article II.
