§ 122-1. Title.

This chapter may be known as the "Returned Check Ordinance."

§ 122-2. Service charge for returned checks.

Whenever a check payable to any account of the Borough of Wood-Ridge is returned for insufficient funds, a service charge of an amount up to twenty dollars (\$20.) per transaction shall be added to the account. The service charge shall be paid and credited before any other payment on the account is accepted and credited.

§ 122-3. Collection of unpaid service charges.

Unpaid service charges shall become delinquent and, when applicable, a lien against property, to be enforced in the same manner as other liens.

§ 122-4. Cash payments required.

Any person whose returned checks become chronic, as determined by the Chief Financial Officer, may thereafter be required to pay in cash or by certified or cashier's check.
