§ 24-1. Means of defense to be provided.

Whenever an active or inactive officer, employee, elected or appointed official of the Borough of Wood-Ridge is a defendant in any action or legal proceeding arising out of or incidental to the performance of his/her duties, the governing body shall provide said officer, employee, elected or appointed official with necessary and reasonable means for the defense of such action or proceeding, other than for his/her defense in a disciplinary proceeding instituted against him/her by the Borough of Wood-Ridge or in a criminal proceeding instituted as a result of a complaint on behalf of the Borough of Wood-Ridge.
