

Chapter 27**ENGINEER****§ 27-1. Appointment; term of office; qualifications.****§ 27-2. Powers and duties.**

§ 27-1. Appointment; term of office; qualifications.

There shall be a Borough Engineer, who shall be a licensed professional engineer of the State of New Jersey and who shall be appointed for a term of one (1) year by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Council. In lieu of appointing an individual to be the Borough Engineer, the Mayor and Council may appoint a firm of engineers, each member of which shall be a licensed professional engineer of New Jersey.

§ 27-2. Powers and duties.

The Borough Engineer shall perform such duties as are prescribed by general law and ordinance and, in addition, shall:

- A. Prepare or cause to be prepared plans, designs and specifications for public works and improvements undertaken by the borough.
- B. Provide and maintain surveys, maps, plans, specifications and control records with respect to public works and facilities owned or operated by the borough.
