§ 256-3. License renewal. [Added 10-12-1994; amended 10-7-1999; 5-7-2009 by Ord. No. 2009-1]

All licenses and permits are to be renewed by January 31. Licenses are not renewed by January 31 are subject to a fine. The members of the Board of Health shall decipher any discrepancy in class.

§ 256-4. Violations and penalties. [Added 10-12-1994]

Any person, licensee or permittee who violates any provision of or order promulgated under this chapter or who shall not obtain the appropriate license or permit shall, upon conviction thereof, be liable to a penalty of not less than \$100 for each violation. Each day a particular violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.
