§ 64-1. Establishment.

There shall be a Department of Public Works, the head of which shall be the Principal Public Works Manager.

§ 64-2. Principal Public Works Manager.

The Principal Public Works Manager shall be appointed by the Mayor, with advice and consent of the Council, in accordance with civil service rules. The Principal Public Works Manager shall be a person qualified by education, training and experience to perform the duties of the office. He shall, prior to his appointment, have secured and be the holder of all necessary state licenses required to supervise and operate the sewerage system of the borough.

§ 64-3. Powers and duties.

The Department of Public Works, through its Principal Public Works Manager, shall take charge and be responsible for the construction, operation and maintenance of public sewers and the operation and maintenance of the sewage disposal plant, the maintenance of borough-owned parks and playgrounds and the care of other public works in the borough, subject to the directions of the Mayor and Council. The Principal Public Works Manager shall supervise the maintenance of all borough streets, highways and other public places, including the streetlighting system. He shall report to and be subject to the orders of the Mayor and Council.
