33	11-14-1900	Union Avenue, called in part South Street
36	1-9-1901	James Street and Fourth Street
258	5-11-1927	A portion of Valley Boulevard, lying immediately north of Highland Avenue
99-19	10-12-1999	Donna Drive (formerly named Industrial Road)

Ord. No.	Date of Adoption	Description of Street Accepted
35	11-14-1900	Mill Road
131	5-29-1912	Gerecke Avenue, Prospect Avenue, Vreeland Avenue, Valley Avenue and Brinkerhoff Avenue
146	8-10-1914	A portion of Ninth Street
255	4-13-1927	Twelfth Street, between Main Avenue and Union Avenue
268	9-14-1927	All those streets not now existing, which are laid down as avenues on a map by Jacob G. Van Riper, Jacob Brinkerhoff and Henry C. Van Riper, Commissioners, bearing the date of November 21, 1872, and filed in the Bergen County Clerk's office
365	5-28-1930	A portion of the westerly side of Valley Boulevard
392	9-12-1934	Alpine Sweep
407	12-10-1936	Roosevelt Avenue, Hoover Avenue, Brandenburg Avenue, Columbus Avenue and Springfield Avenue
409	12-23-1936	A portion of Moonachie Avenue
412	9-8-1937	A portion of a certain proposed street as shown and laid out on a map of Wood-Ridge Manor, Section No. 5, property belonging to Charles H. Reis, Inc.
482	9-27-1950	A portion of Eleventh Street
490	7-18-1951	Eleventh Street, between the southerly side of Highland Avenue and the northerly side of Wood-Ridge Avenue
506	2-18-1953	Railroad Street (now Park Place West) and Union Avenue
516	5-20-1953	A portion of Main Avenue
617	8-16-1967	A portion of Fritsch Avenue, sometimes called "Passaic Avenue"
631	5-21-1969	A portion of Wood-Ridge Street
