## REQUIRED ITEMS

## TUITION

Each application must include payment in full. Make checks payable to: Nick Cipriano. Application and tuition must be received by June 30, 2009. Any application received after June 30, 2009 must be accompanied by a \$10 late fee per child. Applications are processed as they are received. Applications received for a session that has been filled will be returned with your tuition and your name will be placed on a waiting list. In the event of cancellation, you will be notified. Apply early to guarantee enrollment. Included in your camp tuition is an official camp sports pack.

## CANCELLATION POLICY

**Cancellation by camper:** The tuition for each session is non-refundable. The tuition balance is refundable for medical reasons up to the opening day of the registered camp session (except for \$20) provided that the camp is notified by a written request and a physician's statement is furnished.

**Cancellation by camp:** The camp reserves the right to cancel any session(s) by refunding amounts paid for canceled session(s).

## DISMISSALS

The camp reserves the right to dismiss any camper for misconduct without refund.

## INSURANCE:

## CAMP DIRECTOR AND STAFF

Nick Cipriano was the Boys Head Soccer Coach at McNair Academic High School in Jersey City for eleven years. He presently coaches club and select teams in the Metro Youth League, Northern Counties Soccer League, and the Pascack Valley Youth League. He conducts various workshops instructing players, as well as coaches, on the mechanics and techniques involved in the game of soccer. Nick holds a state diploma from the National Soccer Coaches Association of America, as well as an E License from the New Jersey Youth Soccer Association.

Chuck Zegarra is a high school teacher and is currently the Boys Head Soccer Coach at Palisades Park High School. He has eight years of high school coaching experience. He has played on several professional teams and has coached various levels of club and select teams.

In addition to Nick and Chuck, all coaches will be certified coaches and/or have significant experience teaching youth soccer. Depending on the age group, there will be a coach for every six to ten players.
