TUITION

Each application must include payment in full. Make checks payable to: Nick Cipriano. Application and tuition must be received by June 30, 2011. Any application received after June 30, 2011 must be accompanied by a \$10 late fee per child. Applications are processed as they are received. Applications received for a session that has been filled will be returned with your tuition and your name will be placed on a waiting list. In the event of cancellation, you will be notified. Apply early to guarantee enrollment. Included in your camp tuition is an official camp sports pack.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellation by camper: The tuition for each session is non-refundable. The tuition balance is refundable for medical reasons up to the opening day of the registered camp session (except for \$20) provided that the camp is notified by a written request and a physician's statement is furnished.

Cancellation by camp: The camp reserves the right to cancel any session(s) by refunding amounts paid for canceled session(s).

DISMISSALS

The camp reserves the right to dismiss any camper for misconduct without refund.

INSURANCE:

Camper's parents' insurance policy is primary coverage. The camp provides excess accident/medical insurance.
