Hearing of Citizens:

Phil Romero –In attendance on behalf of Babe Ruth Baseball. Two parents from Babe Ruth want their children to be redrafted. In Babe Ruth when a player is drafted as a 13 yr old, the player remains on the same team as long as he is a registered Babe Ruth Player. The draft is only held for new players coming into the program. Commission advised Phil to have the two parents put their request in writing and state the reasons for their request.

Rolando Rojas -in attendance on behalf of Recreation Basketball. Requested the Commission to post their monthly minutes online. Dennis Brubaker stated that he did not feel comfortable doing this especially because the minutes are not officially approved until the following meeting. Anyone can request a copy of the minutes by going to Borough Hall.

Old/Business Committee Reports:

- a. **Dennis Brubaker:** Instant Verification will be at the Civic Center on Saturday January 16th from 10 a.m.- 2p.m. Dennis will not be available for the February 10th recreation meeting. Emil Bevacqua will run the meeting.
- b. **Jerry Lanzerotti:** Soccer will hold an informational meeting on Thursday January 28th.
- c. **Joe Zielinski:** Football held their end of year. All went well. Joe will not be available for the April 14th regular recreation meeting.
- d. **Mike McGahn:** Not in attendance.
- e. **John Gingerelli:** Nothing to report.
- f. **Emil Bevacqua:** Not in attendance.
- g. **Toni Ann Azzolini:** Sat in on referendum presentation representing the Recreation Commission.
- h. **Ezio Altamura:** Brought up the topic of the Memorial Day Parade and asked the commission to come up with some ideas about stimulating interest from the community. Possible ideas included, a barbecue, and a bike decorating contest for the kids.
- i. **Recreation Report (Jacki Goldklang):** Reported on registration totals. Questioned whether we should list the “Coaches that have been cleared for coaching” on the Borough website”. This would help the groups because they would know which of their coaches needed, certification, fingerprinting and background checks. We need to come up with a logo for the coaches id cards.

New Business:

Dennis - Presentation was held during the hearing of citizens to all representatives that were invited from each of the recreation sponsored groups. All coaches must be fingerprinted. Every three years following their fingerprinting, they must have a background check.

Ezio – During the presentation, Ezio explained that the original ordinance was written 3 years ago. We needed to update the ordinance and make some changes because the state changed their requirements. It is mandatory in Wood Ridge if you are coaching kids to be fingerprinted (Borough Ordinance #2009-22)

Next month we will go over the list of liaisons. Toni Ann asked if she could be the liaison to the Adult Softball 35 and over league.

John asked if he could have Babe Ruth.
